OPEN CLASSES

A.C. Oriental Premier Male

GD PC – Janicki's UK & IMP GD PR THAIRANO TILLERMAN (35) 07/11/03

A very stylish and elegant boy. Super head, even and well balanced with very good top line and large flared ears wide set. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Almost straight profile and good firm chin that lines up well with the nose tip, bite very untidy with many incisors missing now, but appeared level. Well defined neck-line, long slender and well toned body, whip tail just about balances. Pristine white coat beautifully prepared, very short and close-lying with gorgeous sleek texture. Excellent temperament and presented to perfection.

Foreign White Neuter

Tabby Point Siamese Kitten

1st & BOB – Gallichan's ATLANTIC DIONYSUS 32/1 M 03/07/09. A well grown baby of very good type. Strong little head with very good top line and large nicely flared ears very well set. Oriental eye shape and set, colour could be a little deeper, particularly for a seal tabby. Strong profile with just a marginal dip to nose, chin firm, bite marginally scissored over at present. Firm and weighty little body of good length, long strong limbs and large spoon paws, tail rather short for balance. Well developed and defined tabby markings. Soft fine coat still clearing of baby shading. A sweet boy very well presented.

2nd – Gallichan's ATLANTIC BLISS DEMETRIUS (32/3) M 03/07/09. This boy appeared to have had a run in with his water bowl which did his coat no favours whatsoever. Not quite so well grown as his brother but overall type and style good. Neat medium wedge with good top of head and large ears well set. Good shape to eyes, slightly straight set at the moment, colour bright mid blue. Baby dips to profile, chin good and bite level. Really solid little body of good length with dainty limbs and paws, longish whip tail that almost balances – the best length tail out of all the kittens. Darker chocolate tabby markings a little underdeveloped with partial scarab, just a hint of a single cheek ribbon and almost non-existent bracelets, rings on tail almost solid and need to break, he also has very tiny thumb prints. Fine and rather fluffy coat today. A friendly boy well presented.

Tortie Point Kitten

1st & BOB – Gallichan’s CATLANTIC DELPHI HONEY (32b1) F 03/07/09. A very promising baby. Super little head with wide top line and large flyaway ears excellently set. Very good eye shape, marginally straight set at present with a very inscrutable expression and excellent depth of colour. Tiny baby growth dips to brow-line at present, good straight nose, firm chin, bite scissored over. Dainty but firm toned and quite weighty body of good length, fine limbs and neat spoon paws, tail rather short and a little thick at the tip. Very dark seal tortie points, beautifully mingled on all points and showing plenty of rich red, particularly the ears. Fairly good texture to coat, lying close and lightly shaded to tone. Excellent temperament and presentation.

2nd – Gallichan’s CATLANTIC DIDO (32b4) F 03/07/09. A daintier girl than her sister but type still very good. Neat and well balanced head with good width between her fairly large ears that were set in line with the wedge. Super eyes for shape and set with deep brilliant colour. Tiny baby dips to profile, good chin and bite. Dainty body of good length, dainty limbs and teeny spoon paws, tail short and rather blunt at the tip. Mid lilac tortie points very well mingled in pale and slightly warmer cream. Unshaded baby coat with soft very fine texture. The sweetest temperament, a very poised and confident baby. Excellently presented.

3rd – Gallicgan’s CATLANTIC DEMETER (32b3) F 03/07/09. This baby was the better grown of the three, of good type though not quite the style of her sisters. Medium length wedge, top of head needs a little more width between her large ears and the setting is marginally high for balance. Strong profile, chin rounds off a touch but bite virtually level. Strong weighty body of good length, long quite strong boned limbs and largish paws, tail short for balance. Darker chocolate tortie points with some warmth tone, well mingled in mainly pale red. Soft fine almost un-shaded ivory coat. Rather shy and not as outgoing as her sisters. Excellently presented.

Tabby Point Siamese Neuter Male

PC & BOB – Janicki’s SHERMESE LIFE O’RILEY (32/1) 10/09/08. A handsome youngster, typically adolescent in appearance but with sufficient size and substance to be acceptable for the certificate today. Type and style very good with well balanced medium length wedge head and large open based ears set to follow. Very good shape to eyes, slightly straight in setting, bright mid blue in colour. Straight strong profile and good chin, bite just about level. Very long neck and body the later good and weighty with a good firm tone to it, limbs long and elegant, tapered tail just about balances. Tabby pattern appears to be ticked based with barely the one third rings to tail, but unusually he has more than the usual single cheek ribbon for this pattern. Lovely coat, very short and beautifully sleek and close, with light ticked shading overall. Super temperament, purred the whole time, bless him. Excellently presented.

Tabby Point Siamese Neuter Female

PC - Laffoley’s CATLANTIC BOUDECIA (32t2) 05/11/07. A big strong neuter girl of good type and style. Medium wedge with good top of head and fairly large ears well set. Lovely eyes for shape set and expression, colour could be a touch deeper for perfection. Straight profile and good chin with level bite. Good weight and substance to longish body, long slender limbs, tapered tail almost balances. Soft blue,

slightly muddy looking, tortie/tabby pattern, with a good balance between tortie and tabby, showing very good mingling in pale and warm cream, particularly on the ears and a touch on the tail rings, nose leather and paws pads blue. Good coat showing some glacial tones, lightly shaded overall in soft blue tortie, length and texture excellent. Rather shy but handled well. Excellently presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.V. Visitors Adult

1st – Gallienne’s CH TALIPAW PERLE DEPLAISIR (27c) F 13/12/04. A most attractive little cat. Good head type with nicely rounded top and medium sized ears set to follow. Good nose break and firm chin. Eyes a touch rounded in shape but colour good. Compact medium length body with medium length tail. Soft pinkie lilac coat with gorgeous satin-like texture. Easy to handle and very well presented.

A.V. Foreign or Oriental Limit Kitten

1st - L’Enfant’s BOUNTIFUL ISIDOR (33a 36e) F 10/04/09. Super baby with a lovely heart shaped face and huge wide based ears. Excellent stop to nose with deep strong chin and level bite. Very good eye shape and expression. Solid little body with long slim legs and long tapering tail. Coat well rexed overall, super for a baby. A very promising little girl. Super temperament and presentation.

A.C. Oriental Neuter

1st – Janicki’s UK & IMP GD PR THAIRANO TILLERMAN (35) 07/11/03

A.V. Aristocrat Neuter

1st – Stmonds’ ANNERA RAMESES (23c) MN 11/02/06. A huge chap, very shy and not showing himself to advantage. Strong head and good ears, profile completely straight and lacking the desired break, chin and bite good. Good eye shape and set colour yellowish green. Very dark blue ticking to coat, undercoat rather cool in tone for this colour and there are some rusty tones showing in places – sunbathing perhaps? Coat texture excellent. Very well presented.

A.V. Senior Neuter

A very large class with some excellent neuters – it was quite a headache to sort them out.

1st – Plaw’s IMP GD PR RAINSONG STEVIE GERRARD (72 45d) MN 07/09/99. It is amazing to think that this handsome and imposing lad is 10 years old. Lovely type with such a strong masculine head for a neuter and really good break to profile, his expression is really wicked, belying his soft easy going nature. Super coat, rich red ticking on pale bright red ground, length and texture excellent. Excellently presented.

2nd - Janicki’s UK & IMP GD PR THAIRANO TILLERMAN (35) 07/11/03

ex 2nd – Symond’s ANNERA AMIRA (23) FN 11/02/06. I love the naughty expression of this lady, but she was not the easiest of ladies to handle and had a very definite time limit with an explosive return to her pen. Her head type is good with large pricked ears set on well, slight break to profile and indent to muzzle, eye shape

and expression good. Gorgeous coat for length and texture with lovely rich dark ticking and orange undercoat. Very well presented.

3rd – Brown’s GD PR ADFURSH MERIC (33 36b) MN 15/11/04. A lovely boy with typical head type, eye shape rounded rather than oval but better when relaxed. Super coat, beautifully rexed, almost like astrakhan, apart from a flat area behind the shoulders where the fur is too short to curl, texture beautifully silky. A sweet boy to handle.
