It was as a pity that several of my Open cats were absent but it was nevertheless a most enjoyable day, and an easy one thanks to my excellent steward Rachael Clarke, who attended to the needs of the cats and myself perfectly.

OPEN CLASSES

A.C. Siamese Balinese GD PR Neuter Male

IMP GD PC – Wallace's IMP GD PR ROZANDEN SIMBA IMFALME (32a) 12/04/03. My lovely old friend with his very well balanced type and serene expression. Even medium wedge with very good top and large open based ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Virtually straight profile, just marginally flat now above the brow line, good firm chin, bite untidy with just two of his lower incisors remaining. Long elegant neck and body, the latter with a good trim tummy line, long elegant limbs and long tapered tail to balance. Excellent points colouring, rich bright red, warm white coat with minimal light red shading, coat length and texture excellent, short sleek and close lying. Perfect temperament, it is always a pleasure to handle this lad. Beautifully presented.

Oriental Black Adult Female

CC & BOB – Walter's NUTROSTAR SECRETLOVE 30/04/08. A dainty lady of overall good type. Longer wedge head with top line marginally narrow for balance, ears size good and nicely flared, set just a mite close but looked better when she relaxed. Oval shaped eyes well set, of olive green colour. Almost straight profile, spot on chin of good depth with level bite, tiny pinch to muzzle. Long slender but deceptively weighty body, long fine limbs and neat paws, whip tail almost balances. Sleek glossy black coat of medium length that was sound to roots, showing a small amount of scurf over the lower back today. Excellent temperament, a happy person who purred the whole time. Very well presented.

Oriental Black Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Debowska's CHAPELROSE CINDERELLA 25/06/09. An extremely promising baby, well grown. Typy head with very good top line and very large jug handled ears that she needs to grow into, set to follow. Good shape and set to eyes with such a haughty expression and olive green colour. Tiny baby growth dips to profile as yet, chin could be a touch firmer but bite level. Super solid little body of very good length with long spidery limbs and long whip tail to balance. Dense black coat sound to roots with super sleek texture for a baby, one or two naughty white hairs showing in the groin area, not enough to justify me withholding but should be tidied up. A very confident and poised baby, purring and making puddings. Beautifully presented.

Apricot Point Siamese Adult Male

CC & BOB – Reed's CH AMYDAY SUNSPANGLED 18/07/08. A superlatively handsome lad. Super head with excellent wide top and huge wide based ears beautifully set. Very good shape and set to eyes, colour medium blue but if I were to nit pick I would like to see a little more intensity of tone. Almost straight profile,

very good chin and level bite. Body very long and elegant, fairly well muscled and weighty, long elegant limbs, tail needs a touch more length and has an irregularity near the tip. Warm muted apricot points with tail typically hotter in tone. Pale lightly shaded coat of slightly soft fine texture but lying fairly close to body. Wonderful temperament, a huge time waster, excellently presented.

Red Point Siamese Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Reed’s JOHPAS REDDY TO STAR 06/08/09. Mouth-watering little girl just my cup of tea. Strong little head for a female, super broad top line and the most enormous flared ears which she does carry low at present but should come into balance as she grows. Very oriental eye shape and set, hairs at the top of the eye lid hang over the outside corner of her eye and make them look smaller than they actually are, colour mid blue. Baby dips to nose and brow line, love her strong “fat” nose, very good chin and level bite. Really solid and weighty little body of good length, quite strong limbs, tail need a little more length and has a slight “something” about a half inch from the tip. Excellent bright red points developing, soft fine baby coat, unshaded. Beautifully poised in her snug nest, completely sure of her own worth and gorgeously. My take away of the day and later Best Siamese Exhibit, congratulations.

2nd – Webster’s SPICESIAM ANISE STAR 17/06/09. This was a nice little baby of good type and style, so very unlucky to be up against the more glamorous winner today. Medium length wedge with good top of head, ears very large, well flared and well set. Oriental eye shape and set with medium blue colour. Small baby dip to nose, chin goes back a touch but bite level. Weighty and quite substantial body of good length, long limbs and tail. Mid red points colour with warm white coat of soft fine baby texture, un-shaded. Very sweet tempered and easy to handle Beautifully presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.C Oriental Adult

1st – Boddy’s PUZZLE DOMINO (48) M 18/07/08. An elegant young lad with longer head that was marginally narrow at the top, ears large and well set. Eye shape and set correct with good green colour. Proportion of white to black about 50/50 with white in all the right places. Extensive bleeding of white into black spoils the overall effect somewhat and could have been tidied up, he also quite a few scattered hairs within the black areas. Very good coat texture. Excellent temperament.

A.C. Oriental Kitten Bred by Exhibitor

1st – Smyth’s APRIKAT STRAWBERRY DELIGHT (62 20d) F 01/08/09. This baby was very promising for type and coat length. At present she has problems with her pattern in that she does have slightly linked spotting on the sides, which are almost sound to roots, but as yet the spine shows little sign of breaking and is an almost solid mantle across her back. She is very young and with the very good length of coat that she has for her age and the minimal difference in colour between pattern and ground, I would give her the benefit of the doubt today, but I would be interested to see her again in a couple of months to see how it has developed. Excellent temperament.

2nd – Partridge’s NUTROSTAR SWEETCARALINE (37h) F 22/05/09. A dear babe of overall good type. Eyes very full and spoil her expression, however colour very good, small pinch to muzzle. Coat warm mid chocolate with medium red mingling, sound to roots and with excellent sleek texture for a baby. Handled well.

3rd – Partridge’s NUTROSTAR REDKNIGHT (37d) M 22/05/09. Litter brother of the 2nd placed kitten and a much more stylish, but unfortunately he has a visible kink about an inch and a half from the tip. What a shame because he is otherwise a very promising boy.

A.C. Oriental Junior Neuter

1st – Titterall’s BABADAG ASIFBYMAJIC MN 06/01/09. This boy continues to improve each time I see him, he has lovely type with a strong beautifully balanced head. His expression is very wicked and the eye colour is good. Very long body now weighty and substantial, good tail. Super coat for length and texture, sleek glossy black and sound. Perfect to handle.

2nd – Taylor’s JADEVYN BRYCHAN TROEDMAWR (48 40bt) MN 19/05/08. A stylish boy but immature looking and slightly effeminate for a boy of this age. Well balanced head with very good top. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of blue. Has well over the one third white required, under tummy and across the chest and shoulders, on limbs and mask. Tabby markings a good warm chocolate. Excellent temperament.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Debutante Adult

1st – Martin’s ABICASA AMAZING GRACE (24) F 26/02/09. A lovely female with excellent type and very good warm toned seal points. The only thing I could fault her on was her eye colour which needs to be deeper for a seal and also shows a slightly paler outer rim. Super coat for length and texture, pale fawn with warm seal shading to tone. Excellent to handle.

2nd – Miles’ ADNIONAM CHINABLUE-KIKI (24b) F 16/02/09. A dear lady, well developed for her age but rather old fashioned in type. Rounded head that needs to be a finer in the muzzle, top line good but ears should be larger. Almond shape to eyes of mid blue. Points colour much too dark and cold for the breed. Very good coat length and texture. Sweet tempered.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Senior Adult

1st – Cockwell’s ADSETAM ONEFORSO (32b1) F 09/07/07. A mature lady of very good type. Medium length wedge well balanced, with very good top of head and large ears well set. Good eye shape and set but colour could be a touch deeper. Dark seal tortie points with plenty of good red mingling. Good coat for length and texture with medium shading overall. A sweet lady.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Kitten Not Bred by Exhibitor

1st – Newman’s MATINES LOOKWHOSTALKING (24) M 27/06/09. A gorgeous little boy with a strong head and lovely size and set to wide based ears. Inscrutable expression to eyes, perhaps marginally deep set, colour very good indeed. Points colour rather cold in tone with cool toned coat to match. Monorchid. Perfect temperament

2nd – Wallace’s ROZANDEN COSIMO (24b) M 28/05/09. Another typy lad, well grown. Stylish medium wedge with very good top of head and large well set ears. Oriental eye shape and set with good depth of colour. Chocolate points colour rather dark but redeemed by a good deal of warmth of tone. Excellent to handle.

3rd – Esterford-Howard’s SHERMESE SHENNANIGANS M (32/1) 10/03/09
This boy has good type and style, but he is rather small for his age and somewhat effeminate looking, he is almost adult but he has some way to go yet. Lovely eyes for shape and set with mid blue colour. Good tabby markings in warm seal. A very sweet boy

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Aristocrat Neuter

1st – Esterford-Howard’s CH MAPU KOFI (32/1) MN 27/05/08. This boy has good type but lacks masculinity and size for age generally. Tabby markings a touch blurred on the mask, tail rings fairly good. Good length and texture to coat with medium shading overall. An easy boy to handle.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Debutante Neuter

1st – Barnes’ ABICASA CYBERSPIRIT (24n) MN 16/12/08. A lovely boy for type and style, still to mature but perfectly acceptable for 11 months. Super head with wide top and very large wide based ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape and set with very good colour. Lilac-based caramel points well developed for age with clear fudgy tones on mask ears and tail. Almost clear off-white coat of very good length and texture. A relaxed and friendly boy.

2nd ?col – Turnbull’s MALIKASIAM MICKALA-MAY (24c) FN 02/05/08. An attractive lady, but more lilac-based caramel than lilac in colour, with suspiciously brownish tones at the base of the ears and under the feet. Eyes large and rather full, of good colour but does tend to squint. Coat off-white rather than magnolia. Handled well.

3rd – Gardner’s BRYTHAIS PEARLRUBY (24) FN20/08/08. A very sweet person but only fair for type with eyes that were full in shape and require more depth of colour for a seal. Lovely points colour, true warm seal - not often seen these days. Superb coat texture.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Senior Neuter

1st – Esterford Howard’s CH & PR MAPU MALACHITE (32/8) MN 18/06/07.
This boy has such a lovely even and well balanced head – I just wish it was more masculine. Bit of dip to nose evident. Lovely eyes for shape, set, expression and colour. Tabby markings rather too soft and pretty for caramel and it is still my opinion that he is lilac. His tail rings are more chocolatey in tone than greyish brown, at two and a half he should be a much dingier colour. Excellent contrast with pale very lightly shaded coat. Super to handle.

2nd – McAlpine’s LYNNOX FRANCESCA (24b) FN 17/06/05. Very stylish indeed with good size and substance, she would have run the winner a little closer if it had not been for the prominent occipital bump at the back of her skull which is quite

visible. Points a touch dark but very warm in tone. Super long whip tail. Excellent temperament.

3rd – Talbot’s PR MORALYN REDARROW (32a) MN 04/03/07. Such an endearing lad of good type. Longer wedge with good top, ears just about large enough to balance, muzzle could be a little finer and he tends to puff out his whisker pads by the look of it. Good eye shape and set with sweet expression and good colour. Good bright red points colour. Such a sweetie to handle.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Visitors Neuter

1st - – Wallace’s IMP GD PR ROZANDEN SIMBA IMFALME (32a) MN 12/04/03

2nd - Esterford Howard’s CH & PR MAPU MALACHITE (32/8) MN 18/06/07

3rd - McAlpine’s LYNNOX FRANCESCA (24b) FN 17/06/05

ex 3rd – Sibley’s ATARIQ FIORI (24c) MN 25/01/09. A good sized boy of good type. Good eye shape set and colour. Points colour rather dark and they lacked pinkish tone. Very good length and substance to body with excellent coat for length and texture. Friendly boy.
