OPEN CLASSES

Seal Point Siamese Neuter Male

Judged fir BOB only and awarded – Copeland's GD PR FLOWERDEW GTXPECTATIONS 02/02/08. A very handsome and elegant boy. Stylish and very well balanced head with excellent top and large flared ears set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with super expression, colour could ideally be deeper for a seal. Strong roman profile, good chin and level bite. Long elegant neck, long weighty yet elegant body, long limbs and spoon paws, tapered tail almost balances. Dense seal points showing some warmth of tone. Creamy fawn coat shaded overall to tone with considerably darker area over the lower back where he has obviously been plucking and it has grown back dark seal, pity. Coat length and texture good albeit a touch sparse in the dark shading still. Excellent to handle and excellently presented.

Tabby Point Siamese Neuter Male

PC – Harrington's PR LOLUJA CASTINGASPELL (32/10) 08/09/07. A large stylish neuter of very good type. Longish wedge with top line marginally narrow for good head balance, ears large and set too follow. Very good eye shape, set and expression with mid blue colour. Almost straight profile, fairly deep chin lines up with the nose tip, bite untidy but level. Good length to body but somewhat portly and as such tends to make his head look a little small in proportion, long limbs and long whip tail to balance. Hot matte apricot tabby markings with good tail rings. Good length and texture to coat with medium shading down the spine to tone. Lovely to handle and excellently presented.

2nd – Budden's JOMESE MUMBO JUMBO (32/1) 06/11/08. A lovely solid little boy with excellent type but more large kitten sized than adult at present. Strong little wedge with excellent top of head and large wide based and well flared ears wide set. Oriental eye shape and set with gentle expression, colour has good depth but is marginally dull in tone. Good profile, chin and bite. Good length to really solid and firm toned body, long limbs and tapered tail that almost balances. Ticked based tabby markings, seal colouring slightly strange, they are rather a greyish seal on all points apart from the tail which is a un-typically warm seal brown. Scarab a little blurred, large thumb prints, pale narrow bracelets, tail just over one third ringed. Super coat, very short and close with light ticked shading overall. Lovely to handle, a very friendly boy, excellently presented.

3rd – Webster's JOMESE JESSIE JAMES (32/1) 06/11/08. Another rather kittenish looking boy of stylish type, litter brother to the previous lad and similar to him in some ways. Medium length wedge with very good top of head and large flared ears very well set. Oriental eye shape, a touch straight set, colour bright mid blue.

Almost straight profile and good chin, bite level albeit marginally untidy with the odd incisor missing. Elegant body of good length with weight appropriate to size. Long slender limbs, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Dark almost black tabby markings, ticked based like his brother thus a little indistinct, with tail barely one third ringed. Excellent coat for length and texture, lying beautifully close, lightly ticked overall. Another friendly boy excellently presented.

Tabby Point Siamese Neuter Female

PC – Haywood’s PR MONARD COSMIC GIRL (32/3) 12/08/05. A shy but gentle mature lady of very good type. Medium wedge, nothing exaggerated just very even and well balanced, with large ears very well set. Lovely eyes for shape set and colour. Tiny dip to profile centre nose, good chin and level bite. Comfortably covered body of good length – when I finally managed to get to relax and uncurl, neat limbs and paws, tail needs an inch to balance. Darker but very warm toned chocolate tabby markings, all nicely defined, with very well ringed tail. Medium length coat of good texture and lying close, lightly shaded to tone. A pity she is so shy, beautifully presented.

2nd – Goddard’s DEBIKAT MARMALADY (32/3) 24/12/08. This lady has come on a good deal since we last met, she is now very well developed for her age and was unlucky to be up against the winner today. There was in fact very little between the two, in the end it was the eye colour that was the decider. Stylish head with very good top line and large open based ears set to balance. Eyes of good shape and set though held a touch wide, colour bright mid blue and there is a hint of a “look” now and again. Almost straight profile and good chin with level bite. Very good substance to long body, long slender limbs and spoon paws, long tail with a small irregularity at the tip. Good warm chocolate tabby markings, ears perhaps marginally cooler in tone, pattern good with well ringed tail. Pale ivory coat with minimal shading, texture a little fine but lays well. Not very happy and had some rude things to say today. Beautifully presented.

Judged for BOB only and awarded – Tobias’ IMP GD PR SHERMESE FUNANDGAMES (32/1) MN 09/09/06. This boy really does have a lovely head, the top line is very wide and his ears are beautifully large and excellently set. Super eyes for shape set and expression, with deep sapphire colour. Strong profile, chin does rather let him down, but it really is the only thing you can fault him on and his bite is level. Very long body with excellent substance and muscle-tone for a neuter, elegant limbs, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Very dark seal tabby markings apart from the tail which is typically black, pattern fairly good with large thumb prints, single cheek ribbons and tail half ringed. Gorgeous coat, very short and sleek with very light ticked shading. Perfect temperament, a beautifully relaxed lad and a pleasure to handle. Excellently presented.

Apricot Point Adult Male

Judged for BOB only and awarded – Reed’s CH AMYDAY SUNSPANGLED 18/97/05. Love the style of this lad, wonderful head, perhaps a mite exaggerated with very wide top line and huge ears set in line. Very good eye shape and set with superior expression, colour mid blue. Good profile, chin goes back a touch, bite marginally scissored over. Very long body, deceptively weighty and well muscled, stands tall on very long limbs, tail has a small irregularity at the tip. Mid apricot

points with tail marginally hotter in tone. Fine textured coat of medium length with light apricot shading over the back. Wonderful temperament for a full male, so very relaxed, loves being handled and doesn't want to go back in his pen. Beautifully presented.

Apricot Point Neuter Male

PC & BOB – Clarke's PR HARTZIE GOLDEN CHANCE 08/09/07. A handsome male neuter of very good type and style. Longish wedge with very good width between large flared ears that were set to follow. Oriental eye shape and set with wicked expression, colour vivid in tone. Good profile and chin with level bite. Weighty and substantial body of very good length, long limbs and well tapered tail that almost balances. Super points colour, rich hot apricot, matching well in tone on all points with tail very hot indeed. Off white coat, perhaps a touch long today and marginally fine in texture but lying quite close, lightly shaded to tone. Rather grumpy as usual, but it does give him a very attractive naughty look. Excellently presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.C. Balinese Breeders

1st – Berry's CHANTEUR MOONFLOWER (61fn) F 23/01/09. Not the largest of ladies and still a touch kitten-like at present, but most attractive for type. Head type very good with wide top and large well furnished ears. Eye shape and set good, colour could be a little deeper. Super apricot points colouring, with good hot tones. Coat length is what you would expect at this age, texture beautifully silky and fine. Excellent temperament

A.C. Breed 32 Siamese not bred by exhibitor

1st – Simpson's CH MAFDET LOVEMUFFIN (32/3) F 29/09/08. A quality lady with excellent type and very good maturity for age. Stylish head with large flared ears. Wicked expression to eyes of very good shape set and colour. Warm mid chocolate tabby markings with very good pattern. Excellent to handle and presented in tip top condition.

A.C Maiden Adult

1st – Payne's GENETTA DCI TAGGART (24c) M 25/01/09. A dear, very immature looking boy with the sweetest of temperaments, - he didn't want to go back in his pen. Type only fair, top of head needs more width between ears that need to be larger for balance and which are set rather upright. Eye colour very good indeed but he does have quite a bad squint. Points colour excellent, soft pinky lilac – good to see these days. Excellently presented.

Seal Point Breeders Kitten

1st – Perkin's CARDELLE THUNDERBIRD M 12/07/09. A very sweet little boy, quite promising for type. Medium length head with good top and large well flared ears nicely set. Super, brilliant colour to oriental eyes. Points colour shows warmth of tone. Fabulous piece of string whip tail. Beautifully presented.

2nd – Simpson's SHERMESE TRULY DIVINE F 10/03/09. For type this lady was very stylish indeed, albeit a touch petite for 8 months. However, her cool toned almost

black points, almost white coat and a paler outer rim to her eyes put her down to 2nd today. Super deep strong chin. Excellent to handle.

Blue Point Breeders Kitten

1st – Perkin’s CARDELLE STOLEN THUNDER M 12/07/09. A promising boy with very good points colour. Good head with fairly wide top and large ears well set. Good shape and set to eyes of fairly good depth of colour, a hint of a squint evident, but possibly because he is teething. Super pale glacial body, un-shaded. Excellently presented,

A.C. Kitten under 6 months

1st – Meek’s MATINES LOOKWHOSTALKING (24) M 27/06/09. A very typy little boy with such a strong head for a baby. Super eyes for shape – perhaps a touch deep set but colour excellent. Points colouring rather cool in tone, coat cooler fawn with minimal shading, Monorchid. Beautifully presented.

2nd - Perkin’s CARDELLE THUNDERBIRD (24) M 12/07/09.

3rd – Webster’s SPICESIAM ANISE STAR (32a) F 17/06/09. Promising baby for type with very good eye colour, points a little pale as yet. Super to handle.

A.C. Visitors Kitten

1st – Janiki’s SHERMESE FABULOUS FABERGE (24) MN 10/02/09. A really lovely boy, excellent for type and style. Very stylish and well balanced head with very large ears beautifully set. He had gorgeous eye colour, deep sapphire blue, dense but warm seal points and his coat length and texture was superb. I look forward to seeing him in his grown up career. Beautifully presented.

2nd - Meek’s MATINES LOOKWHOSTALKING (24) M 27/06/09

3rd – Richards’ DEBIKAT MAYZI-FANAZEE (24n) F 28/02/09. A very stylish little girl, albeit rather dainty for her age. Super points colour and excellent temperament.

ex 3rd – Ellis’ MEILLAND MISTER FINLEY (24) M 02/03/09. Another stylish boy. Points colour slightly chocolatey in tone at present and need to become more dense, and his eye colour could be a touch deeper for perfection. Excellent temperament.

NON-PEDIGREE OPEN CLASS

AOC SH Kitten

1st – Meekings REDWUN (Red SH) MN 23/03/09. An Oriental Red look-a-like and as such has very good type and certainly would not disgrace himself in the pedigree section. Lovely rich red colouring to coat with spotted pattern evident and the condition was excellent, beautifully sleek and close lying. Perfect for temperament,

he was obviously enjoying his day out, purring like a tractor the whole time. Excellently presented.

NON-PEDIGREE MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Best Presented Adult or Kitten

This was a tough class as both were beautifully presented.

1st – Passfield-Taylor’s MC MISTY Tortie FN 2yrs. The sweetest lady, a rag doll look-a-like, such a pretty colour with a very profuse coat that was beautifully prepared and clean white mitts. Lovely eyes, pale blue in colour. Excellent temperament;

2nd – Richard’s KEVIN THEKOUNTRYKAT MN (Ginger & White) 25/09/06.
