OPEN CLASSES

Seal Point Siamese Adult Female

1ST CC & BB w/h – Roberts' STROBER MINIM 14/10/08. A dear seal lady of overall good type. Even medium length wedge with good top of head, ears in proportion and set correctly. Eyes very full in shape and lack oriental expression, I did try and get her to relax in the hope they would improve but to no avail, colour could ideally be deeper for a seal and the rim was marginally paler. Good profile and chin with dear little beard, good clean and level bite. Well covered body of good length, dainty limbs and neat paws, super whip tail to balance. Correct warm toned seal brown points, creamy fawn coat of excellent length and texture, with medium shading to tone. A very sweet tempered lady, such a pity about the eyes. Excellently presented.

Red Point Siamese Adult Female.

1st CC & BOB w/h – Gould's MYLYNN MAISEE B 11/04/09. A very stylish and attractive lady, glaring at me from the confines of her lovely snug bed. I did manage to get her out very briefly but I did not have time to examine her properly, least of all her bite which is necessary if I am to award the certificate. I must confess to pushing my luck with her somewhat, because I did like her and would have dearly liked to have given it, but without success. I did note she had very good points colour and excellent coat contrast. Pity she would not co-operate. Pen presentation excellent.

2nd – Davies' CH JOPHAS RUBY TALLULAH 12/02/09. A typy but rather dainty queen. Well balanced medium wedge with very good top of head and large ears set in line. Oriental eyes that were slightly straight set, mid blue in colour. Small dip to nose, good firm chin and level bite. Body of good length but she is not the most substantial of cats. I did wonder if she had been persistently calling, her spine was rather prominent and overall she seemed a little out of sorts. This also showed in the coat which was long fine and rather open today. Lovely points colour, vibrant red, contrasting well with her virtually unshaded coat. Excellent to handle and pen presentation beautiful. If she had been 100% the placings may very well have been reversed.

Cream Point Siamese Adult Female

CC & BOB – Bunyan's MYLYNN MEANTOBEE 11/04/09. A dainty and very stylish young miss, maturity just about in keeping with age. Lovely head with wide top and large flared ears excellently set. Oriental eye shape set and expression, colour could be a touch deeper but was acceptable. Almost straight profile, good firm chin and level bite, marginal pinch to muzzle. Long slender but firm toned body long dainty limbs with whippy tail that's needs an inch to balance. Pale slightly warm

cream points, lilac based perhaps? Good coat for length and texture virtually unshaded. Excellent temperament, beautifully poised and presented.

Judged for BOB only

Cook's GD CH JOHPAS SABINA PURDITA 09/05/08. I do like the size and strength of this Lady of very good type. Strong head with broad top and very large wide based ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with super expression, unfortunately the lighting today took no prisoners and showed her eye colour as very pale indeed, thus the awarding of the BOB to the younger girl. Excellent strength and substance to long body, long strong limbs and long tail to balance. Slightly warm toned pale cream points, excellent coat for length and texture, lightly shaded overall to tone. An easy lady to handle and beautifully presented.

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

Seal Point Junior Adult

1st - Roberts' STROBER MINIM (24) F 14/10/08

Breeds 32 Siamese Breeders Kitten Male

1st – Ellam's JAKURTZZI KOBEJITZU (32fn) 03/10/09. A promising little boy with stylish head. Not too sure about his colour at this stage, but it does appear to have a slightly dingy overtone to it so happy to accept as apricot on the day. Good short close coat for a baby. Excellent temperament.

Breeds 32 Siamese Breeders Kitten Female

A super class of quality babies.

1st – Reed's JOPHAS REDDY TOSTAR (32a) F 06/08/09. Extremely yummy female, love her size and substance. Wonderful broad head with ears down to her knees at present. Eyes a mite small but this may be due to the downward sloping hairs at the outer corners that give this impression, colour good. Long strong body, good length tail with a tiny "pip". Good bright red points and un-shaded warm white coat. Excellent to handle, beautifully poised and presented.

2nd – Ellam's JAKURTZZI VON ESPER (32c) F 02/10/09. See SCSBE Report

3rd – Withers' TINTALLY SHOOTING STAR (32/1) F 29/10/09. Tiny baby but very promising. Super little head and good expression. Tabby markings coming along nicely. Lots of confidence for one so young.

A.O.C. Non-Breeders Siamese Neuter

1st – Janiki's SHERMESE LIFEORILEY (32/1) MN 10/09/08. See SCSBE Report.

2nd – Clarke's PR HARTZIE GOLDEN CHANCE (32fn) MN 08/09/07. A large but elegant neuter boy of very good type and excellent colouring. In a somewhat better mood than when we last met, and it was only his slightly long and rather fine coat that put him down to second today. Beautifully presented.

3rd – Dinsdale's GD CH & PR APPLEJACK BLUEFENIX (32b2) FN 24/01/04. An attractive lady overall but points colour now more blue-based caramel tortie than

blue with sludgy tones to mask, lots of hot apricot breaks of colour and purple paw pads. Good length to body that was rather too comfortably covered for elegance today and very heavily shaded now. Handled well out of the pen but did her usual explosion of temper as I put her back – bless her. Beautifully presented.

Visitors Neuter

1st – Smout's PR KAMIK FIRECRACKA (32a) MN 18/07/08. See SCSBE Report

2nd – Duncan's GD PR BRYTHAIS SIMPLY RED (32a) MN 30/05/02. See SCSBE Report.

3rd – Whitby's PIPPASTRO HAWKEYE (61n) MN 15/05/09. A lovely Bali boy with good coat length. Points colour needs to develop but he is still very young. What a shame about his tail, as a baby the defect was detectable but acceptable, unfortunately it has become a fixed deviation and if it was not for his long plume hairs would be very noticeable indeed. Handled beautifully, he is a very sweet boy. Beautifully presented.

Phylls Moorley Memorial Class – Siamese or Balinese Adult

1st – Morgan's GD CH ASTRALBLAESE ANDROMEDA (24n) F 21/11/04. An attractive lady, type and style very good. Balanced medium wedge, eye shape looked good today but colour could still be better. Today was an indication of how hall lighting can effect the colour you see, the last time I had this lady was at the Supreme where her points looked very good indeed, whereas to day I thought they could be better developed for a 5 year old. Super coat contrast and lovely texture. Excellent temperament and presentation.
