### OPEN CLASSES

#### A.C. GD PR Siamese/Balinese Neuter Male

**IMP - Brine's GD PR LYNNOX MYSYAMEEZ GALILEO (24c) 07/08/06.** A very stylish and elegant neuter boy. Super head with wide top line and very large beautifully flared ears set to balance. Excellent expression to eyes of oriental shape and set, colour could be a touch deeper but was acceptable for a dilute. Tiny dip to profile over nose, firm chin and level bite. Long well defined neck, long firm toned body with excellent trim tummy line for a neuter, long slender limbs and spoon paws, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Soft greyish points with a hint of pink, well matched apart from the tail which was a touch fawn toned. Medium length magnolia coat with minimal shading to tone, texture and condition excellent. Slightly shy but handled well. Beautifully presented.

**R – Wallace's IGPR ROZANDEN SIMBA MFALME (32a) 12/04/03.** Another stylish and elegant neuter who ran the winner close. Very even and well balanced medium wedge, top line very good and the ears are well flared and set to follow. Lovely eyes for shape and set with very good depth of colour and such a serene expression. Almost straight profile and very good chin, bite lacks most of the lower incisors but appears reasonably level. Long quite heavy body, still with some elegance evident, long limbs and long tail to balance. Good bright red points almost matching with a good amount of colour on the limbs for a red. Super coat, short and close lying with light red shading down the spine. Perfect temperament, a joy to handle as always. Excellently presented.

#### A.C. GD PR Siamese/Balinese Neuter Female

**IMP – Meek's GD PR SHERMESE CHINA DOLL (24) 08/06/07.** A dainty and stylish lady. Very good head with excellent top line and large wide based ears set to balance. Lovely eyes with very good shape set and expression and super deep blue colour. Quite a pronounced dip to nose but chin and bite level. Long dainty but fairly weighty body with a good firm feel to it, long dainty limbs and neat spoon paws, super long whip tail to balance. Very dark dense and slightly cooled toned seal points, well matched. Very good length and texture to coat with medium shading overall. Excellent to handle and beautifully presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> R w/h – Godwin's GD PR GENETTA BLUE HYACINTH (24a) 18/07/03.** A very dear and gentle lady who has some very good qualities but lacks that extra style I personally look for in an Imperial. Medium length wedge with good top of head and largish ears well set. Very good eye shape and set with excellent brilliant colour – her best feature I think. Slight dip to nose, firm chin, clean and level bite with all teeth in situ. Good length to body, fairly trim for a neuter lady, long limbs but tail a bit short for balance. Cool toned blue points, marginally darker than she was as a youngster but

still good. Super close texture to short coat which shows clear glacial tones as per SOP - so rarely seen these days, lightly shaded thus very good contrast for a blue of this age. Excellent to handle, a sweet and very friendly lady, excellently presented.

#### **Oriental Blue Neuter Male**

**PC & BOB – Holt’s ADATEAM DOTNDASH 18/08/08.** A young lad of good type and style, very well developed for 9 months. Medium length wedge with goodish top of head, ears could be a little larger for balance but were well set. Good shape and set to eyes, can hold wide at time, colour two tone with green just seen. Slight dip to nose, firm chin and level bite. Long slightly heavy adolescent body, long strong limbs and oval paws, tail needs an inch to balance. Blue coat looked a touch dark today and was a little unsound on the lower sides, but length and texture excellent. Super temperament and excellently presented.

#### **Oriental Red Neuter Male**

**PC & BOB – Clothier’s PR KASSALIC ROBIN REDFEET 07/05/07.** Not the largest of neuters but very stylish indeed. Longish wedge with very good top of head and large flared ears that almost balance. Small dip to nose and good firm chin, bite very untidy with several incisors missing, appeared level-ish. Good length to firm toned and elegant body, long limbs, but tail much too short for balance. Super rich red coat with just a little diffuse tabby pattern showing, red to roots, medium in length, overall texture a touch fine but lying well. Made lots of loud threatening noises but actually handled quite well. Excellently presented.

#### **Caramel Point Siamese Adult Female**

**1<sup>st</sup> CC w/h – Holt’s ADATEAM SHARANZ SAKURA 18/08/08.** Neat little queen of good overall type but immature and kitten-like and her colouring is somewhat ambiguous at the moment. Medium length head, top could be marginally wider, ears of good size but set slightly high. Very good eye shape, set, expression and colour. Tiny dip to profile, good chin and level bite. Dainty body of good length, slender limbs and neat paws, tapered tail almost balances. Points colour more lilac than lilac based caramel at present. I am mindful that she is very young yet and there is a hint of a brownish tone to the tail and under the feet, the coat is also the correct colour so she may very well just be a late developer. Coat length and texture very good and the contrast is excellent. Super to handle and excellently presented.

#### **A.C. Balinese Adult Male**

**CC & BOB - Smythe’s CH NATHIFA DAIMOND GEEZER (61dt) 16/05/07.** Attractive boy, still somewhat immature looking but he has improved since our last meeting. Broad medium wedge with very good top of head, ear size very good with reasonable furnishings, set to balance. Almost straight profile good firm chin and level bite. Long body with good weight and muscle tone, longish limbs and oval well tufted paws. Very good bright red colouring to tabby markings, tail rings not that evident but can just be seen when plume shaken out. Excellent coat texture, beautifully silky and fine with medium shading to tone. The length is acceptable, although it could ideally be a little longer down the sides, however, it does flow quite well, plume reasonably well furnished. An easy boy to handle, excellently presented.

### A.C. Balinese Adult Female

**1<sup>st</sup> CC w/h – Smith’s JAYMAX HEAVON SENT (61p) 20/06/08.** This lady has very good size and substance, type generally good. Medium wedge head with rather narrow top, ears fairly large but set too high on the head for good balance. Oval shaped eyes of medium blue. Dip to profile over nose, strong chin and level bite, muzzle could be finer and is somewhat square in appearance. Excellent substance to long firm body, strong limbs for a female, tail to balance. Soft lilac-based caramel points, very well mingled in warm mid apricot. Coat needs more length overall and the plume is sparsely furnished, however, texture lovely, very silky indeed. A friendly lady excellently presented.

### MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

#### A.C. Siamese/Balinese Junior Adult

**1<sup>st</sup> – Pounds’ CH JOMESE JENNY MANYDOTS (32b1) F 03/08/07.** I like the type and style of this lady, she is not the biggest of girls but has good weight for size. The eyes are a touch straight set and I detected a hint of a “look” today but colour okay. Tortie mingling excellent, showing good rich red flecks and they were very even throughout. Beautifully poised and relaxed in her snug nest.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Taylor’s MAHEREOE KANDASSIE (24b) M 29/11/07.** If this lad had been a better colour he would have been the winner of this class. Still a little immature looking, but oh so stylish, with a lovely even and well balanced head type. Points colour dark cool toned chocolate, even his coat is incorrect with the texture and colour more in keeping with a seal than a chocolate, pity. Handled beautifully.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Rudge’s MAGICAL MOONLITESONATA (32/4) M 04/05/08.** A great big boy, extremely well developed for his age, of good overall type. Good head with strong profile, chin slopes back a touch, slight pinch to muzzle. Tabby markings very good but beginning to look rather dingy in tone for a lilac. Coat very heavily shaded for a youngster. Rather shy but handled okay.

#### A.C. Siamese/Balinese Senior Adult

**1<sup>st</sup> – Duncan’s CH MALIKASIAM EMIR HARITH (24b) M 11/03/05.** A strong handsome lad. Very good head type with wide top, goodish profile but chin could be stronger. His points colour is dark but shows a reasonable degree of warmth. For such a masculine boy he handles very well indeed.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Dawe’s GD CH BARBECCO STAY WITH ME (32/5) M 18/09/06.** An attractive boy of very good type but lacking the strength and masculinity of the winner. Well balanced head from the front view, but from the side there is a distinct dip to the profile, however the chin and bite are good. Eyes are of good shape and colour but set straight. Tabby markings good but a somewhat paler red. A lovely boy to handle.

#### A.V. Aristocratic Adult

**1<sup>st</sup> – Maule’s LYNNOX HONEY BEE (32/3) F 19/05/07.** Overall an attractive queen. Head type good with very good top line. Eyes good shape and set, perhaps a touch large in proportion to the head size, colour good. Tabby markings in pale chocolate, scarab rather indistinct but tail rings good. An easy girl to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Willis KASSALIC FORBIDDEN SECRET (29) 25/06/08.** Very stylish but rather kittenish at present. Coat colour dark but fairly warm, at present it is unsound and uneven and a little on the long side. Good tempered.

#### **A.V. Local Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Webster's JOMESE JESSIE JAMES (32/1) M 06/11/08.** A tpy little boy but with the emphasis very much on little at the moment, he is small for 7 months which is a shame as he is very promising. Eye colour has good depth but lacks brilliance. A sweet boy, lets hope he is just a late developer.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Chilcott's ANUBIS RAVEL'S BOLERO (32/2) M 04/01/09.** There is something very endearing about this boy, and he has lovely soft pale blue tabby markings, he is also fairly well grown with a good solid feel to him. Top of head could do with more width and his eyes, though very good colour, tend to be rather full in shape.

#### **A.V. Visitors Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Lodwig's MAFDET MAFIOSO (24) MN 04/10/08.** A very tpy boy with huge bat ears – now neutered I see. Eye colour needs depth and has a slightly turquoise tone to the outer edge. Points colour a little cool toned at present but I fancy they have improved since he was tiny. Lovely to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Berry's CHANTEUR MOONFLOWER (61fnt) F 23/01/09.** This baby is very promising for type and colour. Lovely top to head and with large wide based ears set wide. Eyes a touch full but this could improve as the head lengthens, colour could be deeper. Points really hot toned already and tail rings can clearly be seen. Coat length promising for age with super texture.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Button's ALFACENTORY PUTARA (32a) F 04/12/08.** Good type overall with excellent rich red points colour to this baby. Eye colour could ideally be a little deeper.

#### **A.C. Oriental/Oriental Longhair Non-Self Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Hutching's GD PR WILLHAVETODO IMJUSTDIVINE (43e) FN 06/08/07.** I think that I have said all there is to say about this lovely lady and despite the continued doubts about her pattern, I personally am perfectly happy she is what she is supposed to be. Very nervous today

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Wills' WILLHAVETODO PINTSIZEPINTO (48 40) MN 16/05/08.** A very attractive boy for type and pattern. Well balanced head with large ears very well set. Seal points warm in tone for a Bicolour. He has white in all the right places with at least the required one third. I would just like him a little bigger. Excellent to handle.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Tasker's CH & GD PR BUNDOOK OHM MAID (62 43n) FN 25/11/01.** A very dear and senior lady now, with the super caramel colouring and wonderful green eyes. Her pattern is still very doubtful with some soundness seen in places - which is not correct for shaded. Her coat length is very good but the texture is not correct - she has far too much undercoat. Having said all this, it was good to see her again, turned out to perfection and swearing her head off as usual - bless her.

### A.C. Siamese/Balinese Neuter

**1<sup>st</sup> – Kersey’s PR MALIKASIAM WILBUR-MEWZED (24c) MN 06/09/07.** An attractive boy of good type, he still has a somewhat innocent baby look to him but he is not a small cat by any means. Soft pinkish grey points - good to see, and his eye colour is an excellent, deep brilliant blue. Very sweet tempered.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Cockwell’s CARBEILE BOJI STONE ( 32/1) MN 13/07/07.** A dear boy of basically good type. Head a touch unbalanced with narrow top line. Eyes of very good shape and colour but set straight and lacking oriental slant. Coat of very good texture but heavily shaded. Handled very well.

### A.V. Aristocratic Neuter

**1<sup>st</sup> – Watson’s MALIKASIAM MALAIKA SAEEDA (24a) FN 07/10/07.** A stylish girl with good points colour and very good eye colour.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Crumpler’s SARNAJES SULTANOF SWING (24b) MN 03/02/08.** Of good type and style. Good head, but chin rather weak and the bite is overshot. His chocolate points are also very dark. A friendly boy

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Morgan’s ASTRALBLAESE ACHILLES (24b) MN 22/03/08.** This boy has good type but is rather small for his age. Head well balanced, bite very untidy and is undershot. Points colour good but shows extensive brindling at present, particularly under the eyes. A sweet boy.

### Any Siamese/Balinese Adult, Kitten or Neuter born January – June.

**1<sup>st</sup> – Hutching’s GD PR WILLHAVETODO SIR PERCY (24n) 27/05/06.** An old friend, I had him in my Imperial class today and felt he lacked his usually sparkle. It is a pity he has such uneven and quite heavy shading to his coat – what ever the reason, as it does spoil his look. A dear boy to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Morgan’s ASTRALBLAESE AKHENATEN (24) M 11/05/08.** A very nervous boy. His type is good but he lacks masculinity, even allowing for the fact that he is still a youngster. Eyes full in shape and he has a tendency to squint, but colour very good. Points very dark dense and slightly cool in tone. Not very happy to be here I don’t think.

### Any Siamese/Balinese Adult, Kitten or Neuter born July - December

**1<sup>st</sup> – Button’s ALFACENTORY MATARIKI (32a) 04/12/08.** A big strong kitten, well grown, of good type and with rich red points colour. Easy to handle.
