Chocolate, Lilac, Caramel or Cinnamon Point Siamese Imperial/Grand Champion Male

UK GD CC & BOB – Baughan's IMP GD CH MAPU PEPPIE (24n) 22/04/01. A gorgeous boy in wonderful condition for his age, with excellent type and strength. Lovely broad medium wedge with excellent top and very large wide based ears excellently set. Almond shaped eyes well set of very good colour and expression. Dead straight profile which is remarkable in a cat of over 8 years, firm chin and level-ish bite. Excellent length and muscle-tone to body, long elegant limbs, tail a little short for balance. Excellent points colour, sludgy lilac-based caramel. Lightly shaded coat, thus exemplary contrast for a cat of this age, with super sleek texture. Perfect temperament, immaculately presented and turned out – my compliments to his owner.

Chocolate, Lilac, Caramel or Cinnamon Point Siamese Imperial/Grand Champion Female

UK GD CC & BOB – Duncan's IMP GD GC BRITHAIS AURORA (24c) 23/06/05. A lovely little queen, very dainty and feminine. Stylish and well balanced head with lovely wide top and large flared ears set to follow. Lovely eyes for shape, set and expression with deep brilliant colour. Virtually straight profile, good firm chin and level bite. Long, slender but deceptively weighty body, long fine limbs and neat paws, tail needs a touch more length to balance. Pale lilac points that looked good even though the lighting was not helpful. Very lightly shaded magnolia coat of lovely close texture. A very sweet natured female in excellent condition.

2nd – Baughan's IMP GD CH MAPU FORGETMENOT (24n) 10/04/07. A very attractive queen of very good type and style. Neat medium wedge with good top of head and good sized ears well set. Lovely eyes for shape, set and expression with good depth of colour. Profile almost straight, chin firm and bite level. Long elegant body firm toned, long limbs, tapered tail almost balances. Medium lilac-based caramel points, picking out the ghost pattern over her brow and on the tail. Lightly shaded coat of very good length and texture. Excellent to handle, a very friendly lady excellently turned out.

3rd – Morgan’s GD CH ASTRALBLAESE ANDROMEDA (24n) 21/11/04. A mature lady of very good type. Neat medium wedge with very good top line and good sized ears nicely flared and very well set. Oval shaped eyes a touch full, better when she relaxed, depth of colour okay but she has a paler outer rim to them. Very tiny dip to nose, good firm chin and level bite. Long very slender body, long fine limbs and tail to balance. Very good points colour, dark dingy toned lilac-based caramel well matched in colour, front paws paler in tone. Off-white coat with very good contrast, a little long but texture good and lays well. Excellent to handle.

Chocolate Point Siamese Champion Male

GD CC – Duncan’s CH MALIKASIAM EMIR HARITH (24b) 11/03/05. A strong handsome boy of very good type. Broad medium wedge with very good top of head and large ears, well flared, set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with good colour and expression. Almost straight profile, chin slopes back, bite a touch untidy but level. Long muscular body, long strong limbs, long tail to balance. Points rather dark particularly on the head which is beginning to hood, better on the limbs and tail, and he does have some warmth of tone. Ivory coat shaded down the spine, good length and texture, some stud tail evident. Perfect temperament for a full mature male. A very handsome lad – albeit a bit dark.

Chocolate Point Siamese Pre Champion Male

CC & BOB – Gray’s LYNNOX KASANOVA (24b) 23/09/08. A stylish young male with good size and maturity for age, very good head for style and balance with wide top line and very large flared ears excellently set. Oval shape to eyes, holding a little wide, colour could be deeper but was acceptable. Good profile and firm chin, bite clean and level. Long well muscled and elegant body, long elegant limbs, tail well tapered but needs an inch to balance. Warm mid chocolate points well matched for tone, Ivory coat, lightly shaded to tone, with very good close lying texture. Very shy but gentle tempered. A lovely boy. Won the BOB on colour.

Chocolate Point Siamese Pre Champion Female

1st GD CC w/h – Morgan’s ASTRALBLAESE ATALANTA (24b) 22/03/08. A dainty lady of stylish type, not the largest of ladies but good and weighty for her size. Longer wedge with very good top and large open based ears set to follow. Eyes very oriental in shape and slant, colour difficult to discern. Good profile, deep very strong chin, bite very untidy, and even though she has several incisors missing, she is still clearly undershot unfortunately, pinch to muzzle. Long slender body and long fine limbs, whip tail almost balances. Warm mid chocolate points, mask a little patchy on whisker pads. Warm ivory coat with some light shading over hips, length and texture good. A very sweet tempered lady, a shame about her bite.

Lilac Point Siamese Champion Male

1st GD CC w/h – Morgan’s CH ASTRALBLAESE PEGASUS (24c) 28/05/06. A dear boy of good overall type. Medium wedge with fairly good top of head and proportionate ears well set. Oval shaped eyes of medium blue with a hint of a squint evident today. Good profile and firm chin, bite untidy but level-ish. Good length to body, weighty but slightly soft in tone, tapered tail needs a touch more length to balance. Points colouring rather dark and lacked pinkish tone. Admirable contrast to coat of pale magnolia, texture rather soft and fine. The sweetest nature, exemplary in a full male of this age. He just lacks that something extra for a Grand certificate

Lilac Point Siamese Champion Female

GD CC – CH SARAMESE GOODLUCKCHARM (24c) 16/08/08. A stylish queen with very good type. Lovely head for style and balance with very good top of head and large flared ears set to follow. Straight profile with firm chin and level bite. Oriental eye shape and set, colour could be deeper but in the lighting looked acceptable. Long weighty and well toned body, fine limbs and neat paws, tail almost balances. Good points colour with some pinkish tone apparent. Virtually un-shaded coat of sleek close texture. Rather wriggly but not unfriendly. Excellent condition.

Lilac Point Siamese Pre Champion Male

1st CC w/h – Whyte's GENETTA GLENGARRY (24c) 16/07/07. My original notes on this chap may be a little confusing as I wrote him up as a female, - (I obviously did not check an essential piece of equipment), but it does give some indication of his overall lack of masculinity. Having realised my mistake I now write him up correctly with my apologies to the exhibitor. An immature looking boy of overall good type. Strong head with wide top and good sized ears well set. Oval shape to eyes well set, colour mid blue. Dip to profile, firm chin and level bite. Substantial body of very good length with excellent muscle tone, unfortunately he has a small umbilical hernia – my main reason for with holding the certificate. Long limbs and tail. Points colouring very dark, bordering on caramel and more blue toned than pink. Coat colour cool toned off-white rather than magnolia, lightly shaded to tone with the points. Handled well and in excellent condition.

Caramel Point Siamese Champion Male

1st GD CC w/h - Morgans's CH ASTRALBLAESE PERSEUS (24n) 28/05/06. Such a dear boy to handle, type good and points colour excellent. Medium wedge with good top of head, ears could be a little bigger but were set well. Good eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Good length to body and tail. Dingy toned lilac based caramel points, well matched. Body longish and quite weighty but lacks the hard muscle-tone of a mature male. Off white coat with a little shading to tone but quite fine in texture and rather open today. Matchless temperament, I would have been happy to give CC but for me he was not quite up to Grand level today. Excellent condition.

Caramel Point Siamese Champion Female

1st GD CC w/h – Morgan's CH ASTRALBLAESE APHRODITE (24n) 22/03/08. A very dainty female, still quite kittenish for her age but very stylish. Typy head with lovely top and well flared ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with good blue colour. Good profile and chin, bite very untidy with few incisors remaining. Long dainty body with weight appropriate to size, fine limbs and whip tail. Soft fudgy tones to points. Completely un-shaded coat of soft fine texture. Sweet tempered, she purred the whole time but seemed rather out of sorts today. Needs to be more mature for a GD.

Caramel Point Siamese Pre Champion Female

CC – Mason's EPITOME DREAMWEAVER (24n) 14/07/08. Excellent size and substance to this lady of very good type. Medium length wedge with good top of head and good sized ears well set. Basic eye shape good, albeit a touch wide, better when she relaxed, colour good. Good profile and chin with level bite. Lovely

substance to body of good length, tail almost balances. Good dingy toned points developing nicely. Superb coat for length and texture, lying beautifully close. Excellent temperament.

Cinnamon Point Siamese Pre Champion Female.

1st CC w/h – Helm’s TILDEN TINTOFCIN (24k) 30/01/09. Dainty and quite kitten-like lady, just over the 9 months and looking it, type good. Neat medium wedge with good top and fairly large ears nicely set. Oriental eye shape and set with mid blue colour. Straight profile and good chin with level bite, tiny pinch to muzzle. Long dainty but firm toned body, long slender limbs and tail to balance. Lovely rich warm cinnamon points colour well matched. Un-shaded coat of slightly fine texture and the appearance was not helped by her fluffing herself up with pleasure. A very sweet baby, but she needs to mature before she is ready for a CC.

Tabby Point Siamese Kitten Male

It was close for the BOB but the male had the better tabby markings.

1st & BOB – Hutchins’ MAFDET MACARTHUR (32/8) M 23/04/09. A lovely boy, very stylish and quite well grown for age. Excellent head with lovely wide top and very large flared ears excellently set. Super eyes for shape set and expression, colour deep brilliant sapphire. Strong profile with firm chin and level bite. Good firm tone and substance to longish body, tail needs a touch more length to balance – still lacks two pieces of equipment... Caramel colour to tabby markings much improved since our last meeting with very good tail rings in dingy brown. Super coat for a baby. Perfect temperament, easy to handle, in excellent condition.

Tabby Point Siamese Kitten Female

1st – Godfrey & Turner’s MAFDET MISS MOSS (32/1) 14/05/09. Lovely solid baby of super type. Strong little head with excellent top and large butterfly ears set wide. Very good eye shape and set with sweet expression and good colour. Tiny baby growth dips to profile still, good firm chin and level bite. Lovely firm toned and weighty body, long limbs and tail. Ticked based tabby markings with large thumb print, paler narrow bracelets and tail barely one third ringed. Lightly ticked coat of short close texture. A super baby with an excellent temperament.
