My thanks to Harry & Liz for the judging invitation again this year. It was super show with some very good cats to judge. I was fortunate to have Cathy Baxter as my steward and though somewhat overawed with her qualifications, I had a very pleasant day in her company, her handling of the exhibits was excellent and I look forward to next time.

### **OPEN CLASSES**

#### **Tabby Point Female Kitten**

This was a very good class with three quality kittens present

**1<sup>st</sup> & BOB – Bowles Gowdy’s MAFDET MISS MOSS (32/1) 14/05/09.** A very promising little baby with a lovely solid feel to her. Shorter strong wedge head with excellent top and large butterfly ears set wide. Oriental eye shape, set and expression with mid blue colour. Baby growth dips to profile above the brow line and centre nose, good firm chin and level bite. Weighty body of very good length, manubrium marginally prominent but should sort itself out as she grows, dainty limbs and neat paws, whippy tail almost balances. Very dark seal tabby markings, appeared ticked based, with slightly indistinct scarab, single ribbons and large clear thumb prints, tail almost half ringed. Super coat for a baby, very short and close, lightly ticked overall. Excellent temperament, beautifully poised and presented.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Ellam’s ARTENSA UPTOWN GIRL (32/3) 04/03/09.** A dainty and feminine kitten of very good type. Medium length wedge with very good top and large flared ears set to balance. Lovely eyes with a real Siamese expression and excellent depth of colour. Almost straight profile, good chin lines up with the nose tip, bite level. Another kitten with a good solid feel to her, body length very good, tapered tail almost balances but has a small “pip” at the tip. Warm toned mid chocolate tabby markings, pattern still has a fair amount of developing to do, scarab still quite pale and there is just a hint of a single cheek ribbon showing at the moment, tail half ringed. Lovely coat, short close ivory, completely un-shaded. Excellent to handle and beautifully presented.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Simpson’s SHERMESE SHEER BLISS (32/8) 19/06/09.** The baby of the class, also very promising albeit a little shy and retiring today. Typy head with wide top and ears of lovely size and set. Oriental shape to eyes, a touch straight set at the moment, colour very good. Baby dips to profile, good chin, bite level with very tiny lower incisors. Firm little body of promising length, fine limbs and neat paws, whippy tail needs length. Tabby markings in soft toned grey, there is a hint of toffee toned fur under the feet which does suggest caramel rather than lilac so happy to accept him as such today, tracings quite underdeveloped as yet but tail rings good. Soft fine baby coat, un-shaded. A very dear baby, I would be interested to see in him another few weeks, he certainly has potential. Beautifully presented.

#### **Blue Point Male Neuter**

**Judged for BOB only and awarded – Simpson’s IMP GD PR SHERMESE TOO TOO PATOU 04/04/07.** A superior exhibit, but nothing to add to numerous previous reports, handled well today.

**Fawn Point Male Neuter**

**IC & BOB – Wright & Durrant's MEWZISHUN SAXOFAWN 21/06/08.** A huge person of overall good type and wonderful colouring. Longer wedge head that needs a touch more width between his large ears for balance. Oval shape to eyes, expression somewhat innocent, colour could ideally be deeper but it is quite vivid in tone and perfectly acceptable for a dilute. Very good profile with good firm chin and level bite. Substantial body of good length, somewhat full in the tummy line, long strong limbs and large spoon paws, tapered tail almost balances. Super points colouring, soft pale rosy toned fawn, the best I have seen in this colour and this is what earned him his certificate today. Excellent coat, short close and completely unshaded. A slightly shy but obviously well loved boy. Excellently presented.

**MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES****Oriental SH Non-Breeders Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Willis' LEBRETON FINLAY (48 40b) M 28/02/08.** A very stylish and masculine chap. Long wedge perhaps a touch too long for balance but top line good and the ears are very large and well set. Chocolate points seem to have darkened somewhat since we last met but he is still a good colour given the good amount of white he has. Not happy to have his bite looked at today.

**Oriental SH or LH Junior Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Maish's CHIKUAI CALYPSO (37h) F 23/10/08.** This lady, on the other hand, has very good balance to her head, she has lovely type and elegance. Chocolate tortie coat a smidge dark but is warm in tone and has a good deal of rich red mingling, is sound to roots and with length and texture excellent today. Beautifully poised.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Willis' LEBRETON FINLAY (48 40b) M 28/02/08**

**3<sup>rd</sup>- Wildon's SUNJADE SILKMOTH (45k) F 15/10/08.** Very good size and substance to this girl of very good type. Eye colour good, coat colour could be a touch richer in tone, but pattern very good with three bands of ticking evident.

**Ex 3<sup>rd</sup> – Greatorix's CH MEWZISHUN EPHORN (37r) F 21/06/08.** A very shy lady of good type and style with most excellent coat qualities. Soft rosy fawn, completely free of ghosting and sound to roots. Very good eye colour too.

**Any Pattern Tabby, Smoke or Shaded Adult**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Simpson's MAFDET LOVEMUFFIN (32/3) F 29/09/08.** A stylish lady with very good maturity for age. Well balanced head with excellent top and very large ears wide set. Super eye shape set and deep sapphire colour, sporting a hint of a "look" today. Good warm toned tabby markings. Perfect to handle.

**AOC Siamese Non-Breeders Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Muir-Taylor's JOHPAS FATBOY SLIM (32c) MN 12/02/09.** I must say I had a bit of a dilemma with this chap, he is very gorgeous, but not cream. I always thought he was developing in the direction of Apricot and today I am certain of it. The lighting was just dubious enough for me not to wrong colour him. Wonderful head with excellent top and the hugest ears set wide. He also has very good size and development for age. Handed beautifully.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Ellam’s CORSICAN JAKURTZZIS GEM (32b2) F 25/04/09.** A dear little babe, goodish type but a little short all round and her ears do need to be larger. She could also be a bit bigger generally for 5 months but did have a good solid feel to her. Eye colour good. Points colouring soft mid blue with pale cream mingling. Small “pip” to tail tip.

#### **A.V. Limit Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Falconer’s KYOMI HONEYBEAR (37n) MN 12/02/09.** A great big kitten of very good type. Broad medium wedge with excellent top, ears huge and wide based, tending to hang off the side of his head at present and they have a tendency to tilt forward, should sort themselves out as he grows. Eye colour just about green. Coat colouring excellent, sludgy brown toned lilac-based caramel, still shows a fair amount of ghost spotting but better than when we last met. Gorgeous sleek texture to coat. Excellent to handle.

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Bowles Gowdy’s MAFDET MISS MOSS (32/1) 14/05/09**

**ex 2<sup>nd</sup> – Lynch’s FIROUSI FANCY-THAT (48 40b) M 10/02/09.** This boy has come on since we last met and is a decent size for his age now. Lovely head type with super top line and large flared ears set to balance. He has very good depth of colour to his eyes considering the high amount of white he has, including attractive white tip to whip tail. Chocolate colour typically dark and cold in tone. More relaxed today too.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Underhill-Price’s OOPSIEEIDEE SHINING AURA (41n) F17/04/09.** Of the three Classics here today this female had the best pattern. Whilst not perfect, every element was present and well defined, butterfly clear though could show more internal spotting and was a little further down her back than ideal. Three clear solid spine lines and oysters almost complete, it also had very good soundness for this pattern and showed minimal invasion. Colour excellent.

#### **A.V. Visitors Kitten**

**1<sup>st</sup> - Falconer’s KYOMI HONEYBEAR (37n) MN 12/02/09**

**2<sup>nd</sup> - Ellam’s ARTENSA UPTOWN GIRL (32/3) 04/03/09**

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Richards’ DEBIKAT MAYZI FANTAZEE (24n) F 28/02/09.** Very good type, style and colour to this female. Unfortunately her bite looked misaligned today, however I now think I understand why it varies from show to show. It is possible that she has slightly slack ligaments to the jaw at present – or so my steward, who understands these things, seemed to think. It is interesting anyway how she seems to do it, one minute it is there the next not.

#### **Balinese/OLH Non-Breeders Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Holder’s MYLYNN MAGNIFIQUE (62 18) MN05/09/08.** A gorgeous person with wonderful head type, looking very snooty and superior today with his super green eyes. Coat pattern not wonderful but acceptable as spotted and reasonably sound, spine line typically solid. Coat length fairly good today and plume very good, texture as always, beautifully silky and fine. Little bit shy today.

#### **A.V. Limit Neuter**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Cockcroft’s SOLARUS NIRAN CHAO-FAH (29) MN08/06/08.** Such a sweet lad, type basically good but he still has an innocent look to him. Coat very good today, warm perhaps slightly dark Havana brown, virtually sound with just a touch of ghosting on the lower side, length and texture excellent – beautifully sleek.

### **NON-PEDIGREE MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES**

#### **Neuter or Kitten which has never been shown before**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Smith’s FENTON (Apricot SH) 10yrs 3 months.** Embarking on a new and no doubt illustrious career for this titled ex-pedigree chap, he certainly has the personality for it. I always enjoyed our chats in the past and he is still very talkative Wonderful apricot coat colour and vivid green eyes. In immaculate condition for a 10 yr old

#### **Neuter or Kitten originally a stray or rescue**

**1<sup>st</sup> – Chitty’s DONALD (Black & White SH) MN 14 yrs.** It is amazing to think that this chap is 14 years old. Such a super boy with a lovely plushy Bicolour coat and large spudgy feet. He has such a dignified demeanour. In excellent condition.

**2<sup>nd</sup> – Miller’s CLEO-KATRA MILLER (Blue Tortie & White SH) FN 09/03/05.** Such a wicked expression to this very attractive lady neuter with the prehensile tail, curling round my little finger like a chameleon. Virtually bald apart from a large tuft of tortie fur on her nose , she felt just like a hot water bottle. Lovely condition.

**3<sup>rd</sup> – Hutchinson’s PAPAGENA (Tabby Tortie LH) FN April 2008.** A pretty tortie tabby lady with pale amber eyes and a sweet and gentle nature, in very good condition.
