OPEN CLASSES

A.C. Oriental Premier Male

GD PC – Holder’s PR MYLYNN MAGNIFIQUE (62 18) 05/09/08. Magnifique by name and certainly magnifique for type and style this very gorgeous person was also my choice for overall BOV Oriental later in the day. Super head type with excellent top and large well furnished ears set wide. Excellent shape and set to eyes with a wicked expression today, colour vivid green. Good strong profile, very good chin and level bite. Long well defined neck for all the fluff, long substantial yet elegant boy, long strong limbs and oval paws, tapered tail needs a touch to balance. Black tabby pattern could be better defined with spine typically solid, spotting only goes down about one third the length of the hair which is what you would expect of a silver cat, you could say his pattern is not his best feature but then you can’t have everything. Coat length acceptable, it could be touch longer down the sides but frills nicely at he lower edges and the texture is beautifully silky, with plume well furnished. Lovely to handle, a quality boy excellently presented.

R – Weaver’s PR SUNJADE SKIPPER (37k) 27/10/07. An elegant lad with excellent style and substance. Very good head with wide top line and very large ears set to balance. Oriental eye shape and set with naughty expression and hazel green colour. Tiny dip to profile centre nose, good firm chin and level bite. Long elegant neck with long weighty and firm toned body, stands tall on long elegant limbs, tapered tail needs an inch to balance. Warm spicy cinnamon coat, slightly uneven in colour over the lower back but mainly sound and free from ghosting on the body, length and texture very good, sleek and lying close. Rather cross but handled well enough. Excellently presented.

Oriental Shaded Adult Female

CC & BOB – Hatchet’s NUTROSTAR HONEYSUCKLEROSE (43e) 19/09/07. This lady was very attractive for type and style. Longer wedge with top line perhaps a touch narrow, better when she relaxed her large well flared ears, setting correct. Very good shape, set and expression to eyes, colour pale yellowish green. Almost straight profile with marginal bump between the eyes, good firm chin and level bite. Excellent body type, long and slender but firm and weighty, long limbs and neat paws, whip tail needs an inch to balance. Definition between shaded pattern and ground not as clearly defined as I would like, but there does seem to be this problem with the tortie shaded , where the undercoat, due to the tortie mingling, is not as pale as a non tortie shaded. The shading itself appeared good, quite well diffused with some light vestigial spotting on the sides, and she has a good deal of red that is

mingled throughout. Coat texture excellent, very short and close lying. Excellent temperament and presentation

Tabby Point Siamese Adult Female

CC – Meekings' RANTIPOLE ENIGMA (32t8) 06/12/08. A stylish lady perhaps little bit kittenish looking as yet but acceptably so for 10 months. Well balanced medium wedge with good top of head and large open based ears very well set. Lovely eyes for shape and set with excellent deep blue colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Good length to body with good weight, and she is more substantial than she first appears, fine limbs and spoon paws, well tapered tail need a touch more length to balance. Tortie tabby points still rather soft and pretty for caramel but she is still young and the tortie mingling, which does predominate, is acceptable for apricot, tips of ears fairly dark and brownish looking, leg bars very pale, tail rings good. Unshaded off white coat of slightly fine texture but lying close. Rather grumpy but handled okay. Excellently presented.

Judged for BOB and awarded – Simpson's CH MAFDET LOVEMUFFIN (32/3)

29/09/08. This stylish lady was much more mature looking and she has lovely size. Excellent head with very good width between her large wide based ears. Snooty expression to eyes of very good shape set and colour. Good profile and chin with level bite. Long elegant body with excellent substance and tone, long slender limbs, spoon paws, tail just about balances. Well matched mid chocolate tabby markings with paler bracelets and half ringed tail. Ivory coat that was virtually unshaded with super sleek texture. A very posed young lady, excellent to handle and excellently presented

Seal Point Siamese Kitten Male

1st & BOB – Newman's MATINES LOOKWHOSTALKING 27/06/09. A very stylish and promising baby. Super head type with lovely top and very large jug handled ears set wide. Oriental eye shape and set, colour is a deep if slightly dull blue. Baby dips to nose, good firm chin, bite marginally under and this did make me consider withholding the BOB, however he is very young and teething, so fingers crossed it will improve. Long really solid little body, long limbs, super whippy piece-of-string tail to balance. Dense seal points with a little warmth of tone evident, excellent coat for a baby, short and sleek, very lightly shaded to tone. Perfect temperament, - and just the right size for my pocket. What a shame he is monorchid. Excellently presented.

Tabby Point Siamese Kitten Female

1st & BOB – Studer's MAFDET STRIPEEPANTS (32/2) 14/05/09. A beautifully grown female of very good type. Strong medium wedge with wide top line and huge wide based ears excellently set. Eye shape and set correct with lovely expression, colour could ideally be deeper. Almost straight profile, chin has very good depth but slopes away a touch, bite just about level. Solid and weighty body of good length with strong limbs for a female, tail rather short for all that body. Soft medium blue tabby markings with very good tail rings. Super coat for length and texture virtually unshaded. The sweetest temperament, excellently presented

MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES

A.V. Oriental Adult, Kitten or Neuter

1st – Ellis’ GD PR MYLYNN MOONSHADOW (62 20) MN 09/11/06. A very handsome boy looking good today. Very good head type, balanced and even with gorgeous green eyes. Beautifully silky coat but I would just like it a touch longer overall for perfection. Spotted pattern typically linked with solid spine line, warm in tone on a warm ground and reasonably sound for a longhair. A lovely boy to handle too.

2nd – Whiston’s MYOKO CHIQUITITA (48 43bs) F 21/11/08. A very stylish Bicolour girl but rather light-weight today – persistent calling perhaps as she was not in poor condition. Very good for the amount of white that she has, across the chest, shoulders and along the entire length of her belly. Base pattern appears more Ticked than ticked-based Shaded with at least two bands of ticking and with the silver undercoat only just half way up the hair shaft. Showing a fair amount of tarnishing to the head markings today. Excellent temperament and presentation.

A.C. Oriental/Siamese/Balinese Adult

1st – Moss’ IMP GD CH MIDAMYST IVEGOTYUBABE (37) F 30/04/04. This lady is quite gorgeous for style and type, and it was very close between her and the neuter in my BOV line up. Excellent head for style and balance and she has such a wicked look to her good green eyes. Coat almost perfect today, very short sleek and glossy, completely sound to roots. I just wish she was a little more out going. Excellently presented.

2nd – Jones’ GD CH AMYDAY ALMOST HEAVEN (32b8) F 21/08/06. Also very beautiful, with excellent head and lovely large flared ears to balance. Lilac-based caramel tortie points colour very good with attractive paler apricot blaze dividing the mask in two. Just the coat texture the deciding factor between these two ladies today, it was a touch soft and fine. Perfect temperament, purred the whole time. Beautifully presented.

3rd - Whiston’s MYOKO CHIQUITITA (48 43bs) F 21/11/08

Red, Cream, Apricot, Tortie or Tabby Point Siamese Adult

1st – Reed’s CH AMYDAY SUNSPANGLED (32fn) M 18/07/08. A lovely young male, very stylish indeed with the most enormous ears beautifully set, and expressive eyes of medium blue colour. Points colour, while clearly apricot could be a touch more intense in tone, but then he is very young and has time for them to develop. He appeared quite slender but his long body is deceptively weighty. Tail has an invisible “pip” to the tip. A huge time waster – this boy really does know how to sell himself, later Overall BIS – many congratulations.

2nd - Meekings’ RANTIPOLE ENIGMA (32t8) F 06/12/08

A.C. Oriental/Siamese/Balinese Maiden Adult

1st – Dickenson’s LAVINSHI RAINBOWDANCER (24) F 12/07/08. Overall a stylish girl but rather dainty and kitten-like for 15 months. Head type good with very good top line and large ears set to follow. Eye shape and set good, but the colour

needs to be deeper for a seal and is dull in tone, she also has a tendency to squint. Points colour a little on the cool side as is the coat colour which was very heavily shaded “pepper and salt” ticking. Handled well and was excellently presented.

A.V. Oriental Breeders Kitten

1st – Studer’s MYLYNN MAIRFAIR CHIC (62 15) F 08/05/09. A well grown and promising baby but rather shy and not doing herself justice. Good head type with large very well set ears. Eye shape and set good although she was holding them wide with worry today, colour very good. Super coat, length very promising for such a baby, dense glossy black, sound to roots and beautifully silky in texture. Excellent presentation

2nd – Meekings’ RANTIPOLE REMEMBRANCE (48 40b) M 23/03/09. Another promising kitten, also well grown. Well balanced little head, good shape and set to eyes with good colour. What is particularly noticeable is that for a chocolate with white he is a good warm colour. Amount of white uncertain at present, he appears to have some in all the right places, but there does seem to be a couple of islands of non white fur under his tummy, only time will tell if he really does have sufficient white. Excellent temperament and presentation.

3rd – Partidge’s NUTROSTSAR DARKMOON (37) M 03/05/09. A dear little boy of quite good type, unfortunately he has very large full pale green eyes that tend to dominate the head and lack oriental expression. Good coat, dense sound black with good length and texture. Tail rather short. A shy babe very well presented.

A.C. Siamese/Balinese Non-Breeders Kitten

1st – Gould’s MYLYNN MAISEE B (32a) F 11/04/09. A very promising baby for type, but a bit of a baggage to handle. With very good eye shape and colour, and rich vibrant red points she was most attractive. Posing in her beautiful snug nest, butter wouldn’t melt in her mouth, but examining her bite was another matter! Hopefully an off day because she is very nice.

2nd – Bunyan’s MYLYNN MEANTO BEE (32c) F 11/04/09. A bigger and better grown girl than her sister, her type was also very good, but I felt the shape and expression of the eyes was not as good and the colour could be marginally deeper Good pale cream points colour. Much more amenable to handle. Excellently presented.

3rd – Dampier’s SIMPLYSIAM STOLEN KISSES (24b) M 27/02/09. Of overall good type but a touch small for 8 months, although he did have a good solid feel to him. Head marginally narrow for balance, eye colour good. Points rather dark but warm in tone. Super coat for length and texture. Excellently presented.

A.V. Self Kitten

1st - Studer’s MYLYNN MAIRFAIR CHIC (62 15) F 08/05/09.

2nd – Lungren’s SAIKOU THE SUNDANCE KID (37fn) MN 05/02/09. A well grown boy of very good type. Eye colour vivid green. Coat colour a very good hot apricot, showing a fair amount of spotted pattern at the moment but sound to roots, with excellent sleek texture. Lovely temperament.

3rd – Matheson’s MERESCLIFF SORREL (37k) M 29/05/09. A very well grown lad, head a touch narrow and unbalanced, eye colour excellent. Warm cinnamon coat needs to sort itself out, it is showing a good deal of ghosting to the body at the moment and is very unsound. A very sweet boy to handle.

A.V. Oriental Non-Self Kitten

1st Simpson’s SUNJADE TICKLEMYFANCY (45k) F 07/05/09. A mouth-wateringly lovely kitten. Excellent type and beautifully grown, with an excellent rich cinnamon ticked pattern. She has the type of head I personally would like to see more often in Orientals. My notes say “totally edible”.....

A.C. Oriental/Siamese/Balinese Limit Kitten

1st - Newman’s MATINES LOOKWHOSTALKING 27/06/09.

2nd – Bunyan’s MAFDET BLUE MOON (24n) M 22/04/09. Good overall type to this lad with very well developed blue-based caramel points for his age, showing clear brownish tones to mask tail and ears and with deep purple paw pads. Head a touch unbalanced at present and he was sporting a pinch to muzzle today. Eye colour also very good. A sweet boy

3rd – Gould’s MOONFLEET CRÈME DE LACREME (24c) F 11/04/09. A dainty baby of good type and style. Not too sure about her points colour, it appeared on the dark side of lilac and had a slightly fudgy tone, particularly under her paws. Maybe the lighting? Beautifully presented.

A.C. Oriental/Siamese/Balinese Kitten Resident in Kent

1st - Bunyan’s MYLYNN MEANTO BEE (32c) F 11/04/09

2nd – Dunworth’s SHERMESE BLUE CAMELIA (24a) F 24/03/09. A neat baby of good type. Even head with good sized ears, eyes excellent for depth of colour and intensity of tone, although they were rather straight set and there was a distinct hint of a “look” today.

A.C. Oriental/Siamese/Balinese Kitten Not Resident in Kent

1st - Gould’s MYLYNN MAISEE B (32a) F 11/04/09

2nd – Richard’s DEBIKAT MAYZI-FANTAZEE (24n) F 28/02/09. Nicely balanced little female with a stylish head and very good points colour. Still quite dainty for nearly 8 months. Sweet tempered.

3rd - Meekings’ RANTIPOLE REMEMBRANCE (48 40b) M 23/03/09

A.C. Oriental/Siamese/Balinese Neuter

1st – English’s PLEZETOBE AKILA OUBASTET (24b) MN 06/12/08. A very stylish young boy still to mature. Typy head but it needs to strengthen, lovely eyes for shape set and colour. Points colour rather dark but does show some warmth of tone. Good coat for length and texture with minimal shading to tone. Excellent to handle.

Seal, Blue, Caramel or Fawn Point Siamese Neuter

1st – Cosgrove’s PR BETHANJO THEODORE (24n) MN 18/06/07. A large lad of good type, head top excellent with large ears set to follow. Eyes a trifle full in shape and the colour could be a little deeper for perfection. Good points colour. A dear boy to handle

Chocolate, Lilac or Cinnamon Point Siamese Neuter

1st - English’s PLEZETOBE AKILA OUBASTET (24b) MN 06/12/08

A.V. Oriental, Siamese or Balinese Adolescent Neuter

1st - Holder’s PR MYLYNN MAGNIFIQUE (62 18) 05/09/08

2nd – Titterall’s BABDAG ASIFBYMAJIC (37) MN 06/01/09. A very stylish lad unlucky to up against the more mature looking winner in this class. Super head with excellent top line and very large well flared ears set to balance. Wicked expression to eyes of good green colour. This boys coat was superb today, sleek glossy black, completely sound to roots. Excellent to handle.

3rd – Midson’s MYOKO SUPER-TROOPER (48 43bs) MN 21/11/08. A most attractive neuter for type, but how can you be sure he is shaded when he has just a smidge of colour on the head and very little elsewhere? The tail is tabby which tells you nothing. A very high white, all you can be sure of is that he has a tabby pattern of some sort and that pattern is a good warm colour bearing in mind he is silver and a Bicolour. Love his long whip tail.

ex 3rd - English’s PLEZETOBE AKILA OUBASTET (24b) MN 06/12/08

A.V. Oriental, Siamese or Balinese Junior Neuter

1st - English’s PLEZETOBE AKILA OUBASTET (24b) MN 06/12/08

2nd – Hatchett’s TIROLENA MAGIC JASPER (37a) MN 13/04/08. A dear boy of goodish type. Fairly good head but his ears need to be larger for balance. There is quite a dip to profile and the chin slopes back somewhat, bite level. Coat texture interesting, short, fine and lying close with an almost silky texture, reasonably sound to roots. A dear boy to handle

A.V. Oriental, Siamese or Balinese Neuter Resident in Kent

1st – Cartwright’s TIROLENA BLUE DIAMOND (37a) FN 05/09/07. A very sweet lady neuter of fair type. Shorter wedge with rather narrow top, and narrow based ears that need to be bigger. Eyes rather full in shape but colour good. Darker blue coat of very good length and texture, completely sound to roots. Lovely nature.
